

## **BIOGRAPHY – JUSTICE MALCOLM FORGAN GRAY**

Malcolm Gray has been a resident Judge at the Supreme Court of the Australian Capital Territory since 12 October 2000. He was appointed as President of the ACT Court of Appeal on 21 December 2007 following the retirement of Justice Ken Crispin. Appointed as a Queens Counsel SA in 1982 and Queens Counsel NSW in 1986, Justice Gray held the positions of Solicitor General for South Australia 1978-1986, Senior Public Defender NSW 1986-1987, Crown Advocate NSW 1987-1989 and Chief Counsel, Legal Services Commission SA 1989-1991. From 1991-1995 he was a Member of the National Crime Authority and then practiced as a Barrister in South Australia and NSW from 1995-2000.

Justice Gray served as a Colonel, Australian Army Legal Corps, RFD 1978–1997 and was Chair of the State Theatre Company of South Australia 1977–1986 and the South Australian Youth Arts Board from 1989–1996. President of the South Australian Bar Association 1998–2000, Vice-President of the Australian Bar Association 1999–2000 and Vice-President of the Arts Law Centre of Australia 1998-2000 Justice Gray is a current Member of the Cultural Facilities Corporation ACT 2000.
