

BIOGRAPHY – JUSTICE TERENCE CONNOLLY

Terry Connolly was appointed a judge in January 2003. He had been Master of the Supreme Court since 1996. Before this he was a Member of the ACT Legislative Assembly for six years, and served as Attorney General from 1991 to 1995. He was first admitted to practice as a Barrister and Solicitor in South Australia in 1982, and in the ACT in 1985, and was a legal adviser in the Commonwealth Attorney Generals Department and Department of Foreign Affairs. He held Degrees in Law (hons) and Arts from Adelaide University, and a Masters in Public Law from the ANU.

Justice Connolly died on the 25th of September 2007.
