

Justice David Mossop

David Mossop was sworn in as a Judge of the Court on 13 February 2017. At the time of his appointment he was the Associate Judge of the Court, a position which he had held since 2013, first as Master and then as Associate Judge after the title of that office was changed when the *Courts Legislation Amendment Act 2015* (ACT) came into effect on 21 April 2015.

He holds a Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Laws from the University of New South Wales and a Master of Laws (Public Law) from the Australian National University.

He was admitted to practice as a solicitor in 1992. He practised as a barrister for 14 years from 1998 to 2011.

He served as a Magistrate and Coroner from 2012 to 2013.
